### B.3. Type of allocation of quota places:

The Team and individual athletes' quota places are either allocated to the NOC or to the athlete by name as follows:

#### Quota place allocated to the NOC:

- for a Team quota place allocated through Criteria 1 or 2
- for an individual athlete quota place allocated through Criteria 3

#### Quota place allocated to the Athlete by Name:

- for an individual athlete quota place allocated through Criteria 4, 5, 6, and 7
- for the host country quota places and the Universality places

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

### C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of FIG, may participate in the Olympic Games Paris 2024.

### C.2. Age Requirements:

All athletes participating in the Olympic Games Paris 2024 must be born:

- on or before 31 December 2006 for the Men's competitions. A Men's athlete declared as junior prior to his first competition in 2024 will not be eligible to participate in Paris 2024.
- on or before 31 December 2008 for the Women's competitions.

### C.3. IF additional eligibility criteria/requirement:

To be eligible to participate in the Olympic Games Paris 2024:

- all athletes must hold a FIG License valid until the end of the 2024 Olympic Games Artistic Gymnastics competitions.
- all teams must have participated at any of the Qualification Events outlined in sections **D. Qualification pathway** and **F. Reallocation of unused quota places** to be eligible to obtain a Team quota place.
- all individual athletes who are not part of a team, including individual athletes receiving host country places and/or Universality places, must have participated in any of the Qualification Events outlined in sections **D. Qualification Pathway** and **F. Reallocation of unused quota places** to be eligible to obtain an individual athletes' quota place.



## D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

### D.1 QUOTA PLACES

- Events are listed in **chronological order of qualification for Paris 2024**.
- In case of ties at any place, or if an NOC exceeds the maximum of three individual athletes quota places allowed per NOC under criteria 5 and 6, or if an individual athlete obtains a quota place on more than one Apparatus under criteria 5 and 6, ties will be broken by using the tie breaking procedures outlined in the [Artistic Gymnastics tie breaking Procedures](#)

## D.2. HOST COUNTRY PLACES

### Host Country Places Guaranteed

If the participation of the host country at Paris 2024 is guaranteed with a minimum of one (1) men’s athlete and a minimum one (1) women’s athlete through any Criteria outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, the quota places will be allocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible Men’s athlete and/or the next highest ranked eligible Women’s athlete without a qualified team through Criteria 1 or 2 based:

- on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships
- by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, these quota places cannot be allocated at the 2023 World Championships, they will be allocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible Men’s athlete and/or the next highest ranked eligible Women’s athlete without a qualified team through Criteria 1 or 2 based:

- on the All-Around Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held
- by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC

### Host Country Places Not Guaranteed

If the presence of the host country is not guaranteed through any Criteria outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, the quota places will be allocated to the highest ranked eligible Men’s athlete and/or the highest ranked eligible Women’s athlete from the Host Country by name, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, these quota places cannot be allocated at the 2023 World Championships, they will be allocated to the highest ranked eligible Men’s athlete and/or the highest ranked eligible Women’s athlete from the Host Country by name, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the:

- 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) or, if this is not possible:
- the last Continental Championships edition held with All-Around participation and Host Country participation.

## D.3. UNIVERSALITY PLACES

Two (2) Universality places allocated by name will be made available to one Men’s athlete and one Women’s athlete at Paris 2024, provided that the athlete has met the eligibility criteria as outlined in section **C. Athlete Eligibility**.





On 1 October 2023, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Universality places. The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests is 15 January 2024. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of Universality places to the relevant NOCs after the end of the qualification period for the sport concerned.

Detailed information on Universality places is contained in the “*Games of the XXXIII Olympiad, Paris 2024 - Olympic Games Universality Places - Allocation Procedure and Regulations*” document.

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

### E.1. CONFIRMATION OF QUOTA PLACES

Following receipt of the confirmation from the FIG of the allocated quota places after the end of the qualification period for all Gymnastics disciplines, the NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm in writing if they wish to use these quota places, as outlined in section **G. Qualification Timeline**.

After this deadline, unused quota places will be reallocated as per the procedure outlined in section **F. Reallocation of Unused Quota Places**.

### E.2. CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country must confirm in writing to the FIG the use of its host country places two (2) weeks after having received confirmation from the FIG, as outlined in section **G. Qualification Timeline**.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

### F.1. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

The unused allocated quota places will be reallocated, as outlined in section **F. Reallocation of Unused Quota Places**, up until the start of the Paris 2024 Technical Meeting for Artistic Gymnastics.

The provision of a maximum of three individual athletes quota places for NOCs (without a team qualified) must be respected when reallocating unused allocated quota places to the next highest ranked eligible NOC (Criteria 3) or to the next highest ranked eligible athlete (Criteria 4, 5, 6, and 7).

#### Reallocation of unused quota places in chronological order

**World Championships - Team quota places of five athletes (no reserves)**  
Criteria 1 and 2 allocated to the NOC



The unused allocated NOC Team quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC based on the Team Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC based on the Team Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held with a Team participation.

If individual athlete quota places were already allocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible NOC through criteria 4, 5, 6, or 7, these individual athlete quota places by name will have to be included among the five athletes composing the Team (no reserves). These individual athlete quota places by name will then be reallocated in accordance with the reallocation procedure mentioned for criteria 4, 5, 6, or 7.

An NOC (including the host country) declining a Team quota place is not eligible to convert the unused Team quota place for any individual athletes' quota places.

### **World Championships – Individual Athletes' quota places from Non-qualified Teams**

#### **Criteria 3 allocated to the NOC**

The unused allocated NOC Individual Athlete quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC based on the Team Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC based on the Team Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held with a Team participation.

### **World Championships - All-Around Athlete quota places**

#### **Criteria 4 allocated to the athlete by name**

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held.

### **World Championships - Apparatus Athletes quota places**

#### **Criteria 5 allocated to the athlete by name**

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete on the apparatus concerned, based first on the Apparatus Finals results and then, if needed, on the Apparatus Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete on the apparatus concerned, based first on the Apparatus Finals results and then, if needed, on the Apparatus Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held.



### **Apparatus World Cup Series - Apparatus Athletes quota places Criteria 6 allocated to the athlete by name**

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete on the apparatus concerned, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per apparatus per NOC, based on the Olympic Qualification World Cup Ranking List of the 2024 Apparatus World Cup series.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated through the 2024 Apparatus World Cup series, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete on the apparatus concerned, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per apparatus per NOC, based on the Olympic Qualification World Cup Ranking List of the last Apparatus World Cup series edition held.

### **Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) - All-around Athlete quota places Criteria 7 allocated to the athlete by name**

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete based on the All-Around Qualifications results or the All-Around Final results (i.e., at the discretion of the respective Continental Union and as outlined in the Directives concerned) of the 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG).

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG), it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the last Continental Championships edition held in this Continent with All-Around participation.

## **F.2. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES**

### Reallocation within the host country

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete from the host country based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete from the host country, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the:

- 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) or, if this is not possible:
- the last Continental Championships edition held with All-Around participation and host country participation.



### Reallocation outside the host country

If the host country declines its minimum guaranteed quota place, the unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held.

### **F.3. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES**

The unused allocated quota place will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the 2023 World Championships.

If, for any reason as outlined in section **D. Qualification Pathway**, this quota place cannot be reallocated at the 2023 World Championships, it will be reallocated by name to the next highest ranked eligible athlete, by respecting the provision of a maximum of 1 quota place per NOC, based on the All-Around Qualifications results of the last World Championships edition held.

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

### C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of FIG, may participate in the Olympic Games Paris 2024.

### C.2. Age Requirements:

All athletes participating in the Olympic Games Paris 2024 must be born on or before 31 December 2008.

### C.3. IF additional eligibility criteria/requirement:

To be eligible to participate in the Olympic Games Paris 2024:

- All athletes must hold a valid FIG license until the end of the Olympic Games Paris 2024
- Have reached the minimum technical standard established by FIG. Full information regarding the minimum technical standards is available on the FIG official website ([www.gymnastics.sport](http://www.gymnastics.sport))

In addition, to be eligible to compete at the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, NOCs must have participated at the following events:

- Individuals: 2022 or 2023 World Championships or 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG)
- Groups: 2022 World Championships or 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG).

To be eligible for the host country place or the Universality place for individual athletes, the athletes who obtain the quota place must have participated in the 2023 World Championships. To be eligible for the host country place for the group, the NOC must have participated in the 2022 World Championships with a group.

## D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

### D.1 QUOTA PLACES

The qualification events are listed in chronological order of qualification

In case of ties at any place, ties will be broken using tie breaking procedures outlined in the FIG Technical Regulations, Section 3 for Rhythmic Gymnastics.

#### Individual qualification

An athlete can only obtain one (1) quota place for her NOC.

## D.2 HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country is guaranteed a maximum of one (1) quota place for an Individual athlete and one (1) group if not qualified through other criteria. See Host Country Qualification place for individual athletes and Group.



### D.3 UNIVERSALITY PLACES

One (1) Universality place will be made available to eligible NOCs at the Olympic Games provided that the individual athlete has met the eligibility criteria as described in section **C. Athlete Eligibility**.

On 1 October 2023, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Universality places. The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests is 15 January 2024. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of Universality Places to the relevant NOCs after the end of the qualification period for the sport concerned.

Detailed information on Universality places is contained in the “*Games of the XXXIII Olympiad, Paris 2024 - Olympic Games Universality Places - Allocation Procedure and Regulations*” document.

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

### E.1 CONFIRMATION OF QUOTA PLACES

Following receipt of the confirmation from the FIG of the allocated quota places after the end of the qualification period for all Gymnastics disciplines, the NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph G. Qualification Timeline.

After this deadline, unused quota places will be reallocated as per the procedure defined in paragraph **F. Reallocation of Unused Quota Places**.

### E.2 CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

After the last Paris 2024 Qualification Event, the FIG will inform the respective NOC of its allocated quota places. Following receipt of the confirmation from the FIG, the NOC will have 2 weeks to confirm if it wishes to use its quota places or not, as outlined in paragraph **G. Qualification Timeline**.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

#### Individual quota places

#### **Criteria 1 and 2: 2022 and 2023 World Championships**

qualified under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) with one (1) quota places may obtain a second quota place.

**Criteria 3: 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG)** Any unused place from Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible individual athlete(s) based on the Individual All-Around results of the respective Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) from NOCs not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships). The quota places are allocated by name.

If there are no more eligible athletes from the Individual All-Around results of the respective Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) , the attribution will be based on the results of the next highest ranked eligible individual athlete(s) based on the Individual ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualification) of the 2023 World Championships from NOCs not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships). The quota places are allocated by name.

Should the Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) not take place or not be held in April - May 2024 (or another date approved by the FIG), the quota place(s) of the respective continent is (are) lost and will be allocated to the next highest ranked individual athlete based on the Individual ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualification) of the 2023 World Championships from NOCs not already qualified with an athlete under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or 2 (2023 World Championships). The quota places are allocated by name.

### **Group quota places**

#### **Criteria 1 and 2: 2022 and 2023 World Championships**

Any unused place from the 2022 and 2023 World Championships will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC(s) from the results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) of the 2023 World Championships from an NOC not already qualified.

**Criteria 3: 2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG)** Any unused place from Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC based on the Group ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) from the respective Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) from NOCs not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships).

If there are no more eligible Groups from the Group ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) of the respective Continental Championships or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG , the attribution(s) will be based on the results of the next highest ranked eligible Group based on the Group ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) of the 2023 World Championships from NOCs not already qualified with a Group under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships).



Should the Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) not take place or not be held in April - May 2024 (or another date approved by the FIG), the quota place of the respective continent is lost and will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible Group based on the ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) of the 2023 World Championships from NOCs not already qualified under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships) or 2 (2023 World Championships).

## F.2 REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

### Individual quota place

In the case the host country does not use its quota place, the quota place will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible athlete by name from a NOC not qualified through Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships), Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships) or Criteria 3 (2024 Continental Championships (or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG)) based on the Individual ranking results of All-Around Competition (Qualification) of the 2023 World Championships.

### Group quota place

Should the host country place not be used, this quota place will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible NOC from the Group ranking results of the All-Around Competition (Qualifications) of the 2023 World Championships from an NOC not already qualified with a group under Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships), Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships), or Criteria 3 (2024 Continental Championships or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG).

## F.3 REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES

In case the Tripartite Commission is not able to allocate the Universality place, the unused quota place will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible athlete by name from an NOC not already qualified through Criteria 1 (2022 World Championships), Criteria 2 (2023 World Championships), Criteria 3 (2024 Continental Championships or the other Continental Qualifying Event approved by the FIG) or Criteria 4 (host country place) based on the Individual ranking results of All-Around Competition (Qualification) of the 2023 World Championships.

## D.2 HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The host country will be guaranteed one (1) quota place across both genders, if not qualified via the qualification pathway.

If the presence of the host country is neither guaranteed after all other Criteria, the highest ranked eligible athlete from the host NOC (man OR woman) as per the respective Individual ranking results of the Qualifying Round (Q2) from the 2023 World Championships will obtain the quota place allocated to the athlete by name.

In case of a tie between the highest ranked male and female eligible athlete from the host NOC, the quota place will be allocated to the gender with the highest total number of participants in the Qualifying Round from the 2023 World Championships.

## D.3 UNIVERSALITY PLACES

One (1) Universality place will be made available to eligible NOCs at the Olympic Games provided that the athlete has met the eligibility criteria as described in section **C. Athlete Eligibility**.

On 1 October 2023, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) will invite all eligible NOCs to submit their requests for Universality Places. The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests is 15 January 2024. The Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of Universality Places to the relevant NOCs after the end of the qualification period for the sport concerned.

Detailed information on Universality places is contained in the “*Games of the XXXIII Olympiad, Paris 2024 - Olympic Games Universality Places - Allocation Procedure and Regulations*” document.



## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

### E.1 CONFIRMATION OF QUOTA PLACES

Following receipt of the confirmation from the FIG of the allocated quota places after the end of the qualification period for all Gymnastics disciplines, the NOCs will then have two (2) weeks to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as detailed in paragraph G. Qualification Timeline.

After this deadline, unused quota places will be reallocated as per the procedure defined in paragraph F. **Reallocation of Unused Quota Places.**

### E.2 CONFIRMATION OF HOST COUNTRY PLACES

After the last Paris 2024 Qualification Event, the FIG will inform the respective NOCs of their allocated quota places. Following receipt of the confirmation from the FIG, the NOCs will have 2 weeks to confirm if they wish to use their quota places or not, as outlined in paragraph G. **Qualification Timeline.**

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

### F.1 REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline, or is declined by the NOC or if a 2024 Continental Championships does not take place before 31 May 2024, the quota place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC from 2023-2024 Olympic Qualification Ranking List from NOCs not qualified through any other criteria.

If the 2023 and 2024 World Cup Series should not take place, the unused quota places will be allocated according to the Individual ranking results of the Qualifying Round (Q2) from the 2023 World Championships

### F.2 REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

In the case the host country does not use its quota place, the reallocation procedures for unused qualification places listed above will be used.



### F.3 REALLOCATION OF UNUSED UNIVERSALITY PLACES

In case the Tripartite Commission is not able to allocate the Universality place, the reallocation procedures for unused qualification places listed above will be used.
