


#### Probabilidad diaria de precipitación


#### **Heat Countermeasures - Weather Information**

- Tokyo 2020 has been providing weather information to IFs and NOCs so that teams/athletes can prepare for summer weather in Tokyo (e.g. last summer weather data shared in November 2018).
- August 2019, Tokyo 2020 shared climate and weather information with all IFs and NOCs. This included information regarding heatwaves, thunderstorms and typhoons.








#### Typical Village Apartment

- Free-of-charge Wi-Fi in all residential buildings.







#### **Overview**

#### 17.8 million meals in total:

## **Main Dining Hall**

- 24 hours a day, reduced service overnight.
- 2-storey building, 4,300 seats (1,150 on 1st floor, 3,150 on 2nd floor).
- Same menus served on both floors.

#### Menu

- 8-day cycle.
- Best of Japan, European/American, African/Caribbean, Asian/Indian.
- Halal, vegetarian/gluten-free corners.
- Kosher to be pre-ordered at Nutritional Help Desk.



### Grab & Go (TBD)

- Open from 07:00-14:00
- Menu: bread, muffins and whole fruits





#### Plaza Café

- Open from 09:00-21:00
- Menu: croissants, snacks, hot/cold drinks (coffee etc.), ice cream
- Free cold drinks (Coca-Cola products) for athletes

#### **Firearms & Ammunition**

- Deadline to apply via Firearms Registration System 31 May 2020.
- Only athletes who receive permission can posses, store, carry, or transport firearms/ammunition.
- Must be imported as accompanied baggage. Coaches or other officials cannot receive permit on behalf of athletes.




#### **Accreditation Application Requirements: Data Fields**

Refer to Data & Photograph Requirements for Accreditation

Applications (May 2019)

Important to note requirements for names:

 Names should be entered exactly as shown in Passport Machine Readable Zone (MRZ).



Preferred names for athletes ("IF name" fields) must be entered exactly as used in IF database for their sport.




#### **Accreditation Application Requirements: Photos**


#### Photo requirements:


- Facial Recognition Devices for venue-perimeter access control.
- Minimum pixels: 480 (w)  $\times$  600 (h).
- 70-80% of photo taken up by applicant's face.

# New system automatically approves or rejects photos.

Tokyo 2020 cannot produce PVCs for applicants whose photos do not meet requirements.



### **Conditions of Participation (COP) Form**

- Required for all individuals in NOC accreditation categories.
- Downloadable from GMS (ENG/FRE).
- Must be countersigned by NOC President, Secretary General or Chef de Mission.
- Only original forms with original signatures accepted.
- Early submission required as PVCs cannot be validated until COP form received and confirmed in GMS.
- Parent/Legal Guardian Acknowledgment of Consent for Minors required for any delegation member who is considered minor at time of signing form.



### **Entry to Japan**

- PVC acts as visa waiver for up to 90 consecutive days from 24 April to 6 October 2020.
- PVC does not act as transit visa for other countries.
- Passport must be valid for the duration of the stay in Japan, and should be the same document used in accreditation application.
- PVC will not be sent for late applications and NOCs are responsible for visa arrangement in such cases.
- All NOC categories will act as visa waiver (incl. "Ap", "P" and "X")
- Guest passes and Training Access Passes alone do not function as a visa waiver.

### **Tripartite Commission Invitation Places**



- Same process as for the Olympic Games Rio 2016
- A total of 104 places in 16 individual sports will be available for allocation to all eligible NOCs
- Process to be officially launched October 2019
- Tripartite Commission is responsible for the allocation of the quota places
